Annual Meeting for Saturday, November 2, 2013, 10-12pm

- 1. The Board Chair, Jan Kroeger, welcomed the group at about 10:15 and offered a brief group history and the reason for developing new Bylaws. Group focus has changed from being an informative and county advisory group to being an informational, educational, and social group.
